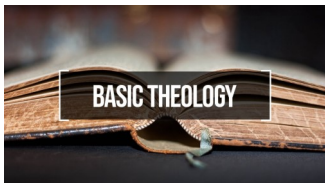


## Sanctuary Choir Resumes

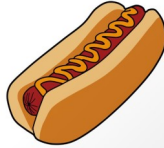
